**1. Install First Aid Kit.**

(A) Place the FAK in the vehicle as stated in the owner's manual. (Remove FAK from package).

(B) If a location is not identified in the owner's manual, place the FAK in the right rear corner of the trunk / cargo area of the vehicle. (Do not remove FAK from package). (Fig 1-1)

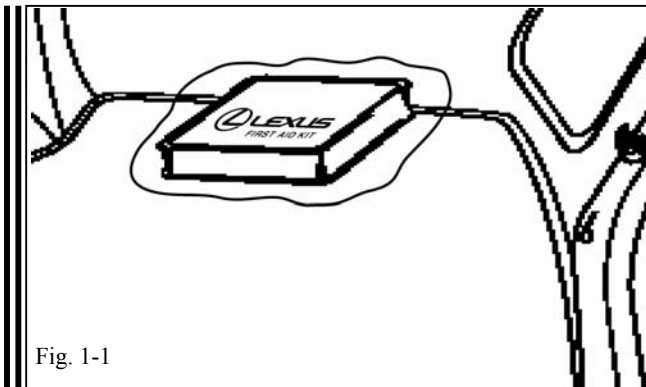
